Teachers' union slams TSA, calls for review

Federation of Education Workers says test questions 'too hard for intended purpose' By KAHON CHAN

- (1) The teacher union, the Hong Kong Federation of Education Workers (HKFEW), has demanded a full review of the Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA) claiming its questions have become too difficult to carry out their first intended purpose.
- (2) According to a survey done by HKFEW, of the 621 teachers and 35 principals who responded, many were not happy with the TSA. Some 53% of teachers agreed the TSA helped them understand their students' basic capabilities. While 57% felt the test was not being used for its intended purpose to know an individual student's achievement and identify students 'learning problems. It also was not helpful for improving teaching and students learning.
- (3) Two-thirds (%) felt the questions were too hard for average primary students; therefore, many schools do a lot of intensive drilling. Four in five teachers felt that students would find the TSA too difficult without drilling. Also, 45% felt that their students had experienced "emotional" problems under TSA pressure and this was a "high price" for students to pay.
- (4) The Education Bureau (EDB) has said that schools drill because of their management teams' "misconceptions." However, HKFEW Vice-Chairwoman, Choi Yuk-lin, disagreed. She said some questions seemed to be written to identify the top 1% of students, rather than test "basic competencies."
- (5) EDB officials have contributed to the high sense of competition, added Ken Wong Kam-leung, the union's vice-chairman and a school principal. He said officials would comment on individual schools' results including openly praising and criticizing a school's TSA performance. "They'd [also] tell principals that their school had done poorly in the TSA and needed to work on it. [This puts] a lot of pressure [on us,]" he said. The EDB has said that TSA data is not used to rank schools, but Wong explained schools doubted this due to a lack of trust.
- (6) In the survey, teachers were divided on the future of the TSA. Some 29% wanted easier questions, but 32% wanted to cancel the Primary Three assessment. The union noted some teachers wanted to keep the TSA only because they feared any replacement could be worse. The union called for more flexibility for schools to engage in the test. They also hoped a revised reporting system of the results could help stop excessive drilling.

TSA has its merits

- (1) A large group of parents of primary school students have announced they will keep their children away from school for three days in protest at the government's refusal to cancel the Territory-wide System Assessment (TSA) for Primary Three students.
- (2) Such a move is very rare in Hong Kong. University student have gone on strike before, but primary students, on the other hand, are not old enough to understand such issues, and their parents usually do not do anything that might affect their studies.
- (3) The fact some parents have made such a radical decision shows that they and their children are overburdened by the issue and it is a real and serious concern. Recently, some of them gave emotional stories at a Legislative Council hearing of how excessive drilling has tortured them and their children, and it has hurt their relationships. One of the mothers even told how her child has the feeling to commit suicide.
- (4) However, we must remember that the TSA has a practical purpose which is to help schools and teachers plan programs for learning and teaching and to help the government review their policies and provide the needed support to schools. The TSA also assesses students' academic capabilities and EDB officials say it is not practical to wait until the Diploma of Secondary Education Examination (HKDSE) in Form 6. All assessments can have negative side effects, but we should not quickly cancel such a useful assessment without thinking about whether these side effects can be overcome.
- (5) Schools have given useful suggestions to lower pressure on schools, parents and students, such as not giving the public schools' assessment results, not testing all students, and promising schools that the EDB will not use TSA results to keep schools open or close them down.
- (6) The government has appointed a 20-member task force to study this issue which will come up with proposals. Parents should be patience and reasonable. They should give these education experts time to study the issue. This will give the authorities time to decide what they can do to make things better without canceling the assessment right away.
